How to Waive the School-sponsored Injury and Sickness Insurance Plan

It's as easy as 1-2-3!

Eligibility Requirements

Good health is essential to your academic success. That's why American University requires all Full-Time degree seeking Residential and International students with F-1 and J-1 Visas to carry personal health insurance. If you are currently enrolled in a health insurance plan that provides comparable coverage to the school-sponsored plan, and that will be in effect through the end of the school year, you may be able to waive the automatic enrollment into the school-sponsored plan by following the steps at right.

- 1** Have your school ID number and current insurance information at hand.
- 2** Go to StudentCenter.uhcsr.com/american between June 18th - Sept. 8th
- 3** Follow the on-screen prompts and answer the required questions.

It's that simple! When you complete the process, you'll see whether your waiver was accepted or denied. If you are in a required category and fail to waive the student insurance before the close of the waiver period, you will be enrolled in the plan and the annual premium will be charged to your student account.
