What preventive screenings and services are available on this plan for adults*?

Alcohol Misuse, Blood Pressure, Colorectal Cancer (ages 50 and over), Depression, Obesity, Sexually Transmitted Infection (population details provided in www.healthcare.gov), Tobacco Use, Immunization recommendations according to www.healthcare.gov.

What preventive screenings and services are available on this plan for women*?

Bone Density, Contraception methods (details provided in **www.healthcare.gov**), Domestic and Interpersonal Violence, Mammography, Well-woman visit.

What preventive screenings and services are available on this plan for children*?

Behavioral Assessment, Depression (for adolescents), Developmental screening (under three and surveillance throughout the childhood), Hearing, Medical History, Obesity, Vision, Routine Immunizations to age 18 (www.healthcare.gov).

How much will I pay for these preventive services?

Benefits are paid at 100% of the Usual and Customary Charges.

Can I still use Student Health Center?

What happens when a preventive visit leads to more testing not on the preventive services list?

Preventive testing that leads to more testing would be processed according to how the claims are billed. If billed with a routine diagnosis, UHCSR will follow the guidelines as indicated on **www.healthcare.gov**. If billed with a sickness diagnosis, claims would be processed as a sickness.

What birth control options are covered?

How much will my birth control prescription cost?

We have a list of the contraceptives that are covered with no cost sharing on the website. Other contraceptive services as listed on **www.healthcare.gov** are not subject to policy deductible or copays and are payable at 100% of the Usual and Customary Charges.
